

The black Madonna, the black Virgin of Chartres

Standing in front of a statue of the Black Madonna in Chartres, France, I immediately notice eight stars forming an arch resembling the seven chakra 's and the seven colors that form the rainbow. Right in the centre I see an eighth star which is larger than the other seven stars. I am being told that this eighth star resembles and forms the connection. Meaning that once again everything will be interconnected. In other words new found knowledge will be the path towards a new creation.

The following words were channeled to me through the Black Madonna on 21-3-2013.

The female blood is a sign of material or earthly ratification of creation. This fact has been long denied and today is no longer fundamentally understood.

The moment a woman becomes pregnant or as you will, bears fruit, the bleeding will stop in order to conserve her strength for the baby. When there is no new life growing

her blood will once again start to flow and the female will symbolically give her life force to all other life. She literally returns her blood to mother earth and to everything around her for in her innermost being she nurtures and cares for progression of life, for all of creation.

For many ages now, this creative force has been completely denied and nowadays is suppressed. In many parts of the world woman are thought to be unclean when menstruating. For instance in some African countries women are forced to separate themselves from their environment by moving into a separate house when going through their cycle. They are not allowed to appear in public as it is feared she is under the spell of evil forces.

In some other religions men do not shake hands with woman out of fear she might be menstruating and therefore thought to be unclean. This goes for the Imam in the Islamic faith and for Orthodox Jewish men. It is said that Islamic woman are not allowed to pray when going through their cycle. There are many other ways whereby this creative life force in woman is being denied thereby taking away her very power.

It is written that the Black Madonna resembles life and death. The female blood creates life, the bleeding of the animal being sacrificed by men, kills life.


